SPECIAL HYMNS OF THE DAY (SMALL ENTRANCE):

First to be chanted as the priest exits the Altar at the Small Entrance is the Resurrection Apolytikion in Tone 1: Τοῦ λίθου σφραγισθέντος ὑπὸ τῶν Ἰουδαίων, καὶ στρατιωτῶν φυλασσόντων τὸ ἄχραντόν σου σῶμα, ἀνέστης τριήμερος Σωτήρ, δωρούμενος τῷ κόσμῷ τὴν ζωήν. Διὰ τοῦτο αἱ Δυνάμεις τῶν οὐρανῶν ἐβόων σοι Ζωοδότα· Δόξα τῇ ἀναστάσει σου Χριστέ, δόξα τῇ βασιλείᾳ σου, δόξα τῇ οἰκονομίᾳ σου, μόνε Φιλάνθρωπε. The stone had been secured with a seal by the Judeans, and a guard of soldiers was watching Your immaculate body. You rose on the third day, O Lord and Savior, granting life unto the world. For this reason were the powers of heaven crying out to You, O Lifegiver, "Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Your kingdom! Glory to Your dispensation, only One who loves humankind!" [SD]

After this, the Resurrection Apolytikion is repeated. Then, the Apolytikion for the Holy Forefathers is heard:

Έν πίστει τοὺς Προπάτορας ἐδικαίωσας, τὴν ἐξ Ἐθνῶν δι' αὐτῶν προμνηστευσάμενος Ἐκκλησίαν. Καυχῶνται ἐν δόξη οἱ Ἅγιοι, ὁι ἐκ σπέρματος αὐτῶν, ὑπάρχει καρπός εὐκλεής, ἡ ἀσπόρως τεκοῦσά σε. Ταῖς αὐτῶν ἰκεσίαις, Χριστὲ ὁ Θεός, σῶσον τὰς ψυχὰς ἡμῶν.

You justified the forefathers in faith, and through them betrothed yourself aforetime to the Church taken from out of the Gentiles. The saints boast in glory. For from their seed, there exists a noble crop, who is she who without seed has given You birth. By their intercessions, O Christ our God, save our souls.

Then, we hear the Apolytikion for the patron saint of our Church:

Κανόνα πίστεως καὶ εἰκόνα πραότητος, ἐγκρατείας Διδάσκαλον, ἀνέδειξέ σε τῇ ποίμνῃ σου, ἡ τῶν πραγμάτων ἀλήθεια· διὰ τοῦτο ἐκτήσω τῇ ταπεινώσει τὰ ὑψηλά, τῇ πτωχείᾳ τὰ πλούσια, Πάτερ Ἱεράρχα Νικόλαε· πρέσβευε Χριστῷ τῷ Θεῷ, σωθῆναι τὰς ψυχὰς ἡμῶν. The truth of things have revealed you to your flock as a rule of faith, an icon of meekness, and a teacher of temperance; for this cause you have achieved the heights by humility, riches by poverty. O Father and Hierarch Nicholas, intercede with Christ God that our souls be saved.

Finally, the Kontakion in Tone 4 for the Nativity of Christ (Dec. 25) is chanted: Ή Παρθένος σήμερον, τὸν Προαιώνιον Λόγον, ἐν Σπηλαίῳ ἔρχεται, ἀποτεκεῖν ἀπορρήτως. Χόρευε ἡ οἰκουμένη ἀκουτισθεῖσα, δόξασον μετὰ Ἁγγέλων καὶ τῶν Ποιμένων, βουληθέντα ἐποφθῆναι, παιδίον νέον, τὸν πρὸ αἰώνων Θεόν. Today the Virgin comes to the cave to give birth ineffably to the pre-eternal Word. Dance for joy upon hearing this, all the world, and with the angels and the shepherds glorify Him whose will it was to be made manifest as a young Child, the pre-eternal God.

TODAY'S EPISTLE READING: Colossians 3:4-11. Brethren, when Christ who is our life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory. Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: fornication, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. On account of these the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience. In these you once walked, when you lived in them. But now put them all away; anger, wrath, malice, slander, and foul talk from your mouth. Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old nature with its practices and have put on the new nature, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator. Here there cannot be Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, freeman, but Christ is all, and in all [RSV]

TODAY'S GOSPEL READING: Luke 14: 16-24. The Lord said this parable: "A man once gave a great banquet and invited many; and at the time of the banquet, he sent his servant to say to those who had been invited, 'Come; for all is now ready.' But they all alike began to make excuses. The first said to him, 'I have bought a field, and I go out and see it; I pray you, have me excused.' And another said, 'I have bought five yoke of oxen, and I must go to examine them; I pray you, have me excused.' And another said, 'I have married a wife, and therefore I cannot come.' So the servant came and reported this to his master. Then the householder in anger said to his servant, 'Go out quickly to the streets and lanes of the city and bring in the poor and maimed and blind and lame.' And the servant said, 'Sir, what you commanded has been done, and there is still room.' And the master said to the servant, 'Go out to the highways and hedges, and compel people to come in, that my house may be filled. For I tell you, none of those men who were invited shall taste my banquet. For many are called, but few are chosen.'" [RSV]





Cathedral Ceiling Repair Update #10, December 8

Repair Progress

In the last restoration update, we reported that new plaster had been installed in all areas but the one that had the cracked joist and that application of the skim coat plaster was underway. Now, all repair plastering and skim coat application are complete.

Also, in the last update, the painting has not started except for test painting for the color match. Now, nearly half of the ceiling is painted. Petrinos Painting has been staffing the job with 2 or 3 painters every day, allowing for quick progress.

Note the three-color pattern on the decorative detail.

The artistic detail throughout the ceiling requires slow-paced detail painting.

The full-room scaffolding that was erected allows multiple painters, sanders, patchers to be working at the same time The painting should complete this month. However, there will still be a lot of work that must be done to bring the Cathedral back to normal. The scaffolding has to be dissassembled and removed. All the protective enclosures and barriers need to be dissassembled and removed. And finally, all surfaces need to be cleaned. We are not sure of the timetable for all of this work but hope that we will be performing the Divine Liturgy in the Sancuary by late January.

Fundraising Efforts

Capital Campaign

The capital campaign was kicked off with an appeal letter to all parishioners. The initial response to this appeal has been great, with \$88,000 donated or pledged to date (Thank You!). The donor form for the ceiling restoration is attached. Please consider making your pledge and/or donation by yearend.

As a memento of the ceiling project, a construction board is available for all donors and project volunteers to sign including signatures of all of your family members. This board will be installed in a non-visible location on the new ceiling. It will act as a permanent connection between your family and your St. Nicholas Cathedral. Please sign this board at the St. Nicholas Bazaar this morning.

Also, for those who wish, engraved pavers can be installed in the existing circle in the parklet along Forbes Ave. Pavers are available at the \$1,250, \$2,500, \$5,000, and \$25,000 level. A pledged donation can be paid over a two-year period.

Fundraising Events and Activities

A committee has met and generated a number of ideas for potential fundraising activities. These events will be planned and organized over the upcoming year. In the short term, the following events are scheduled, so save the dates.


- Raise the Roof Glendi January 7 a young adult oriented dance with a Greek band, mezethes, bar, and lots of Greek dancing.
- Greek2Go January 21 Resurrecting the event that got the Cathedral finances through the pandemic with on-line takeout orders.
- **Popcorn with a Prize** popcorn to be sold at the St. Nicholas Bazaar with proceeds to go toward the ceiling restoration.
- Manthyrea Educational Society Annual Vlahokerasiotiki Makaronada Dinner This year, all proceeds from the event will be donated to the Ceiling Restoration. In addition, the Society will match the proceeds donation, doubling the amount for the project.

The repair of the ceiling was a totally unanticipated problem. Though the repair costs are high, the St. Nicholas parish has devoted parishioners and resources to address the problem and have a Sanctuary that will provide us with another 100 years of worship services.
