




FATHER'S MESSAGE

January 2024

"As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."
(Joshua 24:15)

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the dawn of a new year breaks upon us, bringing with it the promise of fresh beginnings and renewed hopes, let us anchor ourselves in a resolution that supersedes all others: a commitment to wholeheartedly embrace Christ in our lives. Just as Joshua declared his unwavering devotion to the Lord, we should also affirm our own dedication to serving God. But our commitment here is not just a fleeting New Year's resolution, but a lifelong struggle.

In the Divine Liturgy, we repeatedly pray to "commend ourselves and one another and our whole life to Christ our God." This profound invitation beckons us to entrust every aspect of our being—our thoughts, actions, and hearts—to Christ. This commitment to Christ is one we should embrace with open arms, embarking on a journey of faith where Christ is not merely a part of our lives, but the very center.

In another prayer from the Liturgy, the priest entreats God to grant those present in the service "progress in life, faith, and spiritual understanding." This prayer is particularly pertinent as we consider our New Year's resolutions. Often with our resolutions we focus on temporal or worldly goals, but here we pray for progress in our spiritual lives: to deepen our faith, to enhance our understanding of the scriptures, and to cultivate a more intimate relationship with God.

In commending ourselves to Christ, we will quickly learn that our journey with Him is one of continuous growth and learning. Just as a tree grows stronger and taller when it is well-nourished, our spiritual life flourishes when we nurture it with prayer, scripture reading, and participation in the sacraments. This growth is not always clear-cut or without its challenges, but each step brings us closer to *theosis* – oneness with God.

As we embark on this new year, let us reflect on the areas of our life where we can invite Christ in more fully. Whether it be in our personal prayer life, our interactions with others, or our involvement in the church community, each aspect offers an opportunity to demonstrate our commitment to serving the Lord.

Let us also remember that our spiritual journey is not one we undertake alone. We journey together as a community of believers, supporting and uplifting one another.

In the words of the Liturgy, as we commend ourselves to Christ, let us also commend one another, nurturing a spirit of love, unity, and mutual support within our cathedral family.

And so, it is my prayer that this new year be a time of spiritual renewal and growth for all of us. May our hearts be filled with the love of Christ, guiding our actions and decisions. And may our resolution to serve the Lord be the light that guides us through this year and beyond.

THEOPHANY HOUSE BLESSING SCHEDULING FORM

"WHAT IS THEOPHANY?" Each year on January 6 we celebrate the great feast of the Theophany of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, where God is revealed to the world as Trinity. At the Theophany, Christ is baptized in the River Jordan by St. John the Baptist, and we are presented with a great mystery: "He who is the Master of all is baptized by a servant, and He gives mankind cleansing through water."

BLESSING OF HOMES: After the Blessing of the Water Service on January 6, Fr. Eleftherios will begin blessing the homes of our parish with holy water.

WHAT IS A HOUSE BLESSING? In celebration of Theophany — and throughout the month of January — Orthodox Christians invite Christ not only into their hearts, but also their homes. We call upon Him to bring the blessings and spiritual cleansing of the Jordan into our daily lives. The priest blesses our homes with Holy Water from the Theophany service, offering prayers for health, family, and God's abundant blessings in the coming year.

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

- Please prepare a list of your family members' names and an icon for the blessing.
- . The service will begin in the dining room or an area where your icons are displayed.
- You will be asked to guide the priest throughout your home for the Holy Water blessing.
- Kindly ensure a quiet environment by turning off televisions and silencing cell phones.

YOUTH SAFETY WORKERS

Who is considered a Youth Safety Worker?

All Clergymen (Bishops/Priests/Deacons, both

Active & Retired)

Pastoral Assistants & Youth Directors

People assisting, in any ministry, where the participants are under 18 years of age or in high

school, whichever is later.

Including Parish Youth Safety Administrators, Church School Teachers, Dance Directors, Greek School Teachers, Youth Advisors (including Chaperones & Drivers) and Parish Council.

Even... Parents who occasionally help-out, but are alone with other people's children.

Each Youth Safety Worker is required to register yearly with the church.

Registration is available through the church office. In addition, all Youth Safety Workers are required to take two courses (online training platform) annually and to complete a background check every other year.

Here is the website: Please register at https://ncsrisk.org/goarch/. The first course, Youth Safety, has two parts. The second course, Youth Worker Regulations, has one part. Prompt completion is necessary as one cannot participate in any youth programs without being registered, having a background check, having PA state clearances, and completing the two courses.

New Metropolis Center Construction Update

At the writing of last month's report, we were introduced to unstable soils in the deepest portion of our excavating, at the elevator pit. Further testing in and around the entire site resulted in overall positive results except in and around the elevator pit. According to our geotechnicals, onus was upon us to over excavate the elevator pit by many feet and backfill with compactible clay. You'll see the huge difference in color in the first upper left picture where above is brown/tan compatible soil and at the bottom of the pit, the solid turns to a dark blue green color of carbonaceous shale containing pyrite. As adjacent soils to the elevator became suspect and tested poorly, footers within a dozen feet of the elevator had to be removed, soils replaced/compacted and footers redone. This interloping effort cost us the month of

Incremental costs to date hover around \$20,000 with another \$10,000 Testing Compactible Clay anticipated in further soil remediation. By all accounts, the worst is behind us, and we have already begun replacing footers with the expectation of footers-completion before the holidays.



Notably, the Liokareas brothers have been a joy to work with as they were quick to point out the soil issues. Would every other GC be willing to forego a month's income waiting on engineers, testing, results, recommendations, over-excavating, backfilling, compacting, more testing, etc., or would another firm be quick to 'bury' the problems and move on with no regard to the integrity of the building in time to come? And for all of the delay, this month's construction costs are approximately \$135,000.

Again, don't be left out! Your family and your parish MUST be represented. Generations to come will look for their original connection to the center. With the advent of construction, more parishes and individuals are pledging.


