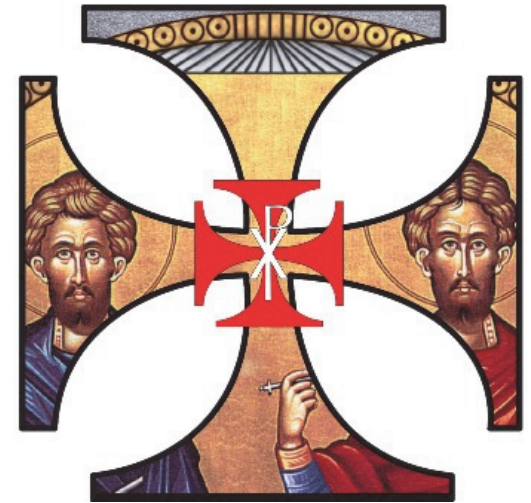


The Philoptochos Mission
