FATHER'S MESSAGE

May 2025

"He is not here, for He is risen, as He said." (Matt. 28:6)

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Χοιστὸς Ἀνέστη! Christ is Risen!

Each Pascha, we greet one another with the words "Christ is Risen!" These are not only words of joy—they are also a call to action. In the light of the Resurrection, we are invited to forgive as we have been forgiven and to love as we have been loved by the One who sacrificed His life for all of humanity. For the Risen Christ comes not to condemn, but to fulfill all righteousness. He forgives His betrayers, He comforts the fearful, and restores the fallen. In Him, all things are made new. And in the brilliance of His Resurrection, we are called to forgive, to reconcile, and to live not for ourselves but for one another.

One of the most powerful hymns of the Feast proclaims: "It is the day of the Resurrection. Let us shine brightly for the festival, and also embrace one another. Brethren, let us say even to those who hate us, 'Let us forgive everything for the Resurrection.'" This is the heart of Pascha—not only that Christ is risen, but that we rise with Him and to Him when we forgive. In the Risen Lord, we are no longer held captive by past misdeeds. We are free. He has freed us. And we are invited to extend that same freedom and that same love to others.

It is in that same spirit of Resurrection—of love freely given and joy shared together—that our Cathedral family comes together for the 63rd Annual Greek Food Festival. What a beautiful expression of our faith it is to see so many, both young and old, offering their time, talents, and their hearts for the good of our Cathedral. This labor of love is more than an event; it is a living icon of our life in Christ: a community united in joyful service, working side by side in celebration of our Orthodox Christian faith and Hellenic heritage.

FATHER'S MESSAGE, Con't

May this holy season of Pascha find us not only celebrating the Resurrection with our words, but also living it with our lives. May we be quick to forgive, eager to serve, and joyful in hope. And with one voice, let us cry out from the depths of our hearts: Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen!

YOUTH SAFETY WORKERS

All Clergymen (Bishops/Priests/Deacons, both Active & Retired) Pastoral Assistants & Youth Directors

People assisting, in any ministry, where the participants are under 18 years of age or in high school, whichever is later.

Including Parish Youth Safety Administrators, Church School Teachers, Dance Directors, Greek School Teachers, Youth Advisors (including Chaperones & Drivers) and Parish Council.

Even... Parents who occasionally help-out but are alone with other people's children.

Each Youth Safety Worker is required to register yearly with the church.

Registration is available through the church office. In addition, all Youth Safety Workers are required to take two courses (on-line training platform) annually and to complete a background check every other year.

Here is the website: Please register at https://ncsrisk.org/goarch/. The first course, Youth Safety, has two parts. The second course, Youth Worker Regulations, has one part. Prompt completion is necessary as one cannot participate in any youth programs without being registered, having a background check, having PA state clearances, and completing the two courses.
