Celebrating 1700 Years from the First Ecumenical Council in Nicaea

This beautiful icon of the First Ecumenical Council shows the 318 Holy Fathers in solemn assembly, holding the Nicene Creed inscribed in Greek—the very words that emerged from their historic deliberations in Nicaea in 325 A.D. At the center is Emperor Saint Constantine the Great, who convened the Council, surrounded by the hierarchs who courageously defended the truth that Christ is "of one essence with the Father" against the Arian heresy. These "luminaries who shine like stars in the spiritual firmament" defined the dogma of the one essence and nature of the Trinity, handing down this formula of faith to the Church. Celebrated each year on the Sunday between Ascension and Pentecost, this feast of the Holy Fathers reminds us that when we recite "Πιστεύω εἰς ἕνα Θεόν" (I believe in one God...), we join our voices with these holy defenders of Orthodoxy, including our own patron Saint Nicholas of Myra, who stood fearlessly for the truth that Jesus Christ is true God and true man.

FATHER'S MESSAGE

June 2025

Πιστεύω εἰς ἕνα Θεόν, Πατέρα παντοκράτορα... I believe in one God, the Father Almighty...

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This June, on the Sunday between our Lord's Ascension and the Feast of Pentecost, we celebrate as we do each year the Feast of the Holy Fathers of the First Ecumenical Council. This year, in 2025, we find ourselves amidst a most extraordinary anniversary, marking 1700 years since those 318 hierarchs gathered in Nicaea in 325 A.D. What a profound gift it is to reflect upon the lasting witness of those Holy Fathers who, under the guidance and patronage of the Emperor of the Roman Empire, Saint Constantine the Great, courageously defended the very essence of our Orthodox faith.

When we recite the Nicene Creed at every Divine Liturgy, we echo the same unshakeable proclamation that emerged from that sacred assembly: that our Lord Jesus Christ is "of one essence" ($\acute{o}\mu oo\acute{v}\sigma\iota o\varsigma$) with the Father. This was no mere theological exercise or academic debate, but a defense of the truth that Christ is fully God (and fully man), the very heart of the Gospel. A clergyman named Arius had dared to teach that "there was a time when the Son was not" — that the Son's begetting happened in time, making Him a created being rather than eternal God. The Church knew that if Jesus were not truly and eternally God, then our salvation would be meaningless, for only God himself could conquer death and grant us eternal life through His Resurrection.

But why should this ancient Council matter to us today? Because what happened in Nicaea still shapes everything we believe and practice as Orthodox Christians. Here are a few reasons why Nicaea is still relevant to us today:

Nicaea matters because Jesus Christ matters.

If Christ is not truly and fully God, then He cannot truly or fully save us. But because He is "Light of Light, true God of true God," as the Creed proclaims, He can enter into our suffering, defeat death, and restore us to life. The decision of the Council is not just dogma; it is the foundation of our hope.

Nicaea matters because our patron saint was there.

Among those present was our own beloved patron, Saint Nicholas of Myra in Lycia! His zealous defense of Christ's divinity — even to the point of striking Arius in righteous indignation — reminds us that truth is worth defending with passionate conviction. Though initially reprimanded for his actions, Saint Nicholas was vindicated through divine vision. His episcopal rank was restored as testimony to his holiness and the righteousness of his cause. The same saint known for his compassion and generosity also stood with courage when the truth was on the line.

Nicaea matters because unity matters.

Hierarchs came to Nicaea from across the known Christian world, from the farthest reaches of the Roman Empire and beyond. In a time without cars or phones or planes, they made the journey because unity in the truth mattered that much. In our age of division and isolation, their witness calls us to be the Church not only in name, but in love and truth. The Council also worked to unify the celebration of Pascha — establishing that it would fall on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the vernal equinox — so that Christians everywhere could proclaim the — Resurrection with one voice, a reminder that our shared faith in Christ's divinity is stronger than our differences.

Nicaea matters because passing on our faith matters.

For 1700 years, Christians have preserved and passed on the Creed, from one generation to the next, across continents and cultures. The question for us today is not whether the Creed will endure, but whether it will endure in us. Will we pass on not just the words, but the living faith that moved Saint Nicholas to risk everything for truth? Will we teach it with the same passion? Will we live it with the same courage?

As we contemplate this momentous moment in the life of our Church, let us recognize that the faith of Nicaea is not simply doctrine to be recited, but life to be lived. When we confess that Jesus Christ is true God and true man, we proclaim that the Divine has entered fully into our human experience: into our joys and sorrows, our suffering and hope.

In this anniversary year, may we draw strength from the witness of the Holy Fathers. May we treasure the faith they preserved and be faithful stewards of this inheritance for the generations yet to come. May their clarity inspire our own understanding, and may their courage stir in us a bold and humble love for the truth.

Through their prayers, and by God's mercy, may we too confess with unwavering faith and conviction: that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

We show our thanks through Stewardship.


Our stewardship helps to fill in the gaps as Festival monies can only go so far.






























YOUTH SAFETY WORKERS

All Clergymen (Bishops/Priests/Deacons, both Active & Retired) Pastoral Assistants & Youth Directors

People assisting, in any ministry, where the participants are under 18 years of age or in high school, whichever is later.

Including Parish Youth Safety Administrators, Church School Teachers, Dance Directors, Greek School Teachers, Youth Advisors (including Chaperones & Drivers) and Parish Council.

Even... Parents who occasionally help-out but are alone with other people's children.

Each Youth Safety Worker is required to register yearly with the church.

Registration is available through the church office. In addition, all Youth Safety Workers are required to take two courses (on-line training platform) annually and to complete a background check every other year.

Here is the website: Please register at https://ncsrisk.org/goarch/. The first course, Youth Safety, has two parts. The second course, Youth Worker Regulations, has one part. Prompt completion is necessary as one cannot participate in any youth programs without being registered, having a background check, having PA state clearances, and completing the two courses.






