FATHER'S MESSAGE

July 2025

"When [Jesus] was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to [Luke and Cleopas]. And their eyes were opened and they recognized him..." (Luke 24:30-31, RSV)

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we journey through these summer days, I invite you to ponder on the moment when our Lord revealed Himself—after the Resurrection—to the disciples on the road to Emmaus. In the simple act of breaking bread, their eyes were opened, and they recognized the Risen Christ in their midst. This sacred moment speaks to the heart of our faith and our ongoing encounter with our living God.

How often in our own lives do we walk alongside Christ without fully recognizing His presence? Much like those two disciples, our hearts may burn within us as we hear His word, yet it is in the breaking of the bread—the Divine Eucharist—that our spiritual eyes are truly opened. The Church has always seen in that moment at Emmaus a glimpse of the Eucharist—a sacred encounter where Christ reveals Himself through the blessing, breaking, and sharing of bread. Each time we gather for the Divine Liturgy, we are invited into that same mystery, where Christ makes Himself known to us in the most intimate way possible.

The Emmaus encounter teaches us that Christ meets us in our journey, especially in our moments of confusion, doubt, or sorrow. The disciples were walking away from Jerusalem, perhaps discouraged by the events of the Crucifixion, when a stranger joined them on the road. (The disciples didn't know it was Christ.) Our Lord did not abandon them in their uncertainty but drew near to walk with them, to listen to their concerns, and to illuminate their understanding through the Scriptures.

Saint Augustine beautifully captures this mystery when he writes: "The teacher was walking with them along the way and he himself was the Way" (Sermon 235.1-2). This profound insight reminds us that Christ is not merely instructing us about the path to God—He is Himself the path. Even when we fail to recognize His presence, He walks alongside us, guiding us to salvation with Him.

This summer, as many of us travel for our summer vacations or find ourselves in different routines, let us remember that Christ is our constant companion. Whether we are at home or away, in familiar surroundings or new places, He walks with us...always. Our recognition of His presence comes not through grand gestures but like a gentle breeze (cf. 3 Kingdoms 19:12) through the quiet moments of prayer, through the reading of Scripture, and most especially through our participation in the Eucharist.

FATHER'S MESSAGE, Con't

The disciples' experience also reminds us of the importance of hospitality and community. They invited the stranger to stay with them, saying, "Stay with us, for it is toward evening." In their openness to welcome another, they received the greatest gift—the revelation of Christ Himself. Let us follow their example by opening our hearts and homes to others, for in doing so, we may entertain Christ unawares.

This Gospel is read during Orthros as the fifth Eothinon, part of the eleven-resurrection Gospel cycle observed throughout the year. The accompanying hymns draw out the mystery of Christ's self-revelation to His disciples. This reminds us that Christ's revelation to us comes according to His divine wisdom and timing...it will happen when He wants it and how He wants it. Just as He gradually opened the disciples' understanding—first through Scripture, then through the breaking of bread—so too does He reveal Himself to us in small doses, preparing our hearts to receive Him more and more fully.

As we celebrate the Eucharist each Sunday, may we approach with the same eager anticipation as those disciples, knowing that Christ will make Himself known to us in the breaking of the bread. And when we drive out of the church parking lot and go back to the craziness of our world, may we carry that recognition with us, seeing Christ in one another and in all those we encounter on our daily journey.

May this summer season be one of spiritual sight and insight, where our eyes are continually opened to recognize our Lord's presence in our lives, in our community, and in the world around us.





All Clergymen (Bishops/Priests/Deacons, both Active & Retired) Pastoral Assistants & Youth Directors

People assisting, in any ministry, where the participants are under 18 years of age or in high school, whichever is later.

Including Parish Youth Safety Administrators, Church School Teachers, Dance Directors, Greek School Teachers, Youth Advisors (including Chaperones & Drivers) and Parish Council.

Even... Parents who occasionally help-out but are alone with other people's children.

Each Youth Safety Worker is required to register yearly with the church.


Registration is available through the church office. In addition, all Youth Safety Workers are required to take two courses (on-line training platform) annually and to complete a background check every other year.

Here is the website: Please register at https://ncsrisk.org/goarch/. The first course, Youth Safety, has two parts. The second course, Youth Worker Regulations, has one part. Prompt completion is necessary as one cannot participate in any youth programs without being registered, having a background check, having PA state clearances, and completing the two courses.



We once again had Essay, Poetry and Iconography Divisions which were judged remotely. We had a total of 19 participants in these categories.
