August 27: St. Phanourios the Great Martyr and Newly-Revealed

Saint Phanourios is commemorated on August 27. His icon was discovered miraculously intact among the ruins of a church on Rhodes, depicting him as a young soldier holding a cross and a lit candle, surrounded by scenes of his martyrdom. Though little is known of his life, the Church immediately recognized him as a saint, and his name — derived from the Greek phanerono, "I reveal"—reflects his role as one who brings hidden things to light.

Beloved especially in the Greek-speaking Orthodox world, Saint Phanourios is invoked for finding lost items or clarity in times of confusion. In thanksgiving, the faithful traditionally bake a phanouropita, a simple oil-based cake offered in his honor and shared with others. More than a finder of misplaced things, Saint Phanourios is a radiant witness to Christ, revealing the steadfastness of faith even in suffering.

FATHER'S MESSAGE

August 2025

"Deliver us, all of your servants, from danger, O Theotokos; after God, we all flee to you, for shelter and covering, as an unshakable wall and our protection." (from the Small Paraklesis)

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Each year, the Church invites us into a sacred rhythm of prayer during the $\Delta \varepsilon \kappa \alpha \pi \varepsilon \nu \tau \alpha \delta \gamma \sigma \sigma \sigma \sigma \zeta$, the first fifteen days of August, through the beautiful services of the Paraklesis to the Theotokos.

The Paraklesis is a service of intercession offered specifically for the living—supplicatory canons chanted during the Dormition Fast that give voice to the prayers of the faithful: for healing, for peace, for consolation, and for strength. Names of family and friends are lifted up, especially those who are suffering in body, mind, or soul. And we ask the Panagia to pray for them—to pray with us and for us. "Disperse the storm of my grief," we sing, "for those in great sorrow, you are joy."

The Orthodox Church has always understood the saints as living members of the Body of Christ, not as distant or inaccessible figures. Just as we would ask a dear friend to pray for us, so we ask the saints. And chief among them stands the Theotokos, our "Champion General," our fervent intercessor, and the mother of us all.

We do not worship her; we honor and venerate her as the Mother of God and the most faithful disciple of her Son and our God. Her intercession is powerful because her love is pure. And as any good mother would, she never ceases to pray for her children.

During these August evenings, we alternate between two canons: the Small Paraklesis and the Great Paraklesis. While most of us are probably more familiar with the Small Paraklesis, both are beautiful services filled with psalms, hymns, and petitions that express our fallen humanity from the depths of our sorrows, fears, and needs—and gently lead us to hope in Christ.

The tone of these services is deeply personal and pastoral. In these prayers, we hear the echoing cries of the faithful through the centuries, and we are reminded that we are not alone in our struggles.

The Virgin Mary listens. And she prays.

FATHER'S MESSAGE, Con't

I invite you to join us for these services. Come and offer your burdens. As we lift up names before the Lord, come and pray for those you love... and even for those you struggle to love.

This is what the Church does: we pray for one another and with one another. Through the intercessions of the saints—especially the Panagia, who never ceases her motherly care for us—we draw nearer to Christ.

As we approach the Feast of the Dormition, may these days of fasting and prayer be filled with grace, comfort, and renewal for our souls—through the prayers of the Most Holy Theotokos.



What is a Steward?

A Steward is someone who cares for our church, its property and finances. As stewards, God asks each one of us to give of their time, talent and treasure.

What is a Pledge?

A pledge is a promise /covenant to help support our beloved Saint Nicholas. Your support helps the church pay its bills, maintain the property and enhance the ministries.

Your pledge is the church's source of income. Without pledges of support, Saint Nicholas would not be able to pay its bills, maintain their property or have outreach through its many ministries. Your pledges keep the lights on, the air conditioning and heat.
